



Our entire assortment of **perennials and grasses** originate from **vegetative propagation** (cuttings, rootcuttings, division).

We use a slightly fertilised peat/perlite **substrate** for the cultivation of our plants. When necessary, our plants are also fertilised with a slow release fertiliser so that they are supplied with adequate nutrients before they are delivered.

For all of our young plants, **Bacillus subtilis** is used as a soil inoculant in order to prevent soil-borne fungi and **Biomükk** is used to prevent infestations of sciarid fly larvae.

According to their growth habit, our young plants are cultivated in different trays.

4x4 (54) = 4cm cells (Teku one-way, 54 plants/tray), e.g. Delphinium, Pennisetum

3x3 (80) = 3cm cells (Teku one-way, 80 plants/tray), e.g. Cotula, Aster, Armeria

2.5 (104) = 2.5cm cells (Teku one-way, 100 plants/tray), e.g. Lavandula, Coreopsis verticillata

5cm (54) = 6-angular cells with a diameter of 5 cm (one-way, 54 plants/tray), e.g. Miscanthus

Fertil (54) = 4cm wood fibre pots with standard substrate (Teku one-way, 54 plants/tray), e.g. Epimedium

Vlies (80) = 3cm fleece paper pot (Teku one-way, 80 plants/tray), e.g. Waldsteinia ternata

The number in brackets () shows the amount of plants per tray.

The standard size for each plant is specified in the list of products. The cell size may differ, if required by the production. **Plants are delivered only in their trays.**

The **delivery time** is specified for every plant. You will receive an order confirmation with the approximate delivery date. Shortly before the delivery, exact dates will be agreed upon via fax, e-mail or telephone. You may specify your preferred delivery date – we will take it into consideration.

We prepare **plant divisions** so that they are ready for planting (this means that the shoots and roots are trimmed). The divisions normally have 1-2 shoots and they are ideal for 9cm pots. Prices are calculated on this basis. Larger divisions (e.g. grasses for containers in the spring) may also be delivered; the prices must be stipulated. The minimum purchase is 100 plants per item. Delivery dates upon arrangement.

An **(S)** next to the variety name stands for **plant variety protection**. The plants may only be propagated with permission by the holder of the plant variety protection rights. The symbol (S) is required for every trade level. Names in CAPITAL LETTERS are trade names. **All prices of the varieties marked with (S) include the license fees.**

Individual consultation regarding delivery dates and plant sizes is available upon request!

CONTINIS® - 6cm or 7cm goods for delivery in the spring are for 1-3 litre containers.

We produce them only when ordered in advance. For spring 2020, the latest order must be placed in July/August 2019.

CONTINI® grasses can be delivered in the same summer if ordered by February.
